## Carpool (How to survive it and keep your sanity)

This means that we have over 600 students that need to move through the parking lot twice a day. Please help us to keep everyone safe by following the rules and procedures. Remember:

- Turn right into the parking lot— please do not block traffic
- Wait patiently for vehicles ahead of you to move forward
- Load and unload students as close to the gym door as possible
- Only turn right out of the parking lot
- Do not show disrespect with gestures (Essential 55, Rule 8)

# Morning Drop-Off

- ⇒ Enter the parking lot at the north entrance. Do not turn left into the parking lot as this creates unsafe conditions for other vehicles and for parents and students crossing the street.
- ⇒ Pull through the drop-off lane all the way to the gym doors. Students will get out of the vehicle at the furthest point.
- ⇒ Students will walk down the sidewalk to the main doors and enter the building.
- ⇒ Vehicles will turn at the end of the parking area and turn down the parking lane.
- ⇒ Vehicles will exit the parking lot at the south exit. Please do not turn left across oncoming traffic.
- ⇒ You may park in the marked parking across the street. Please walk your student across the street.
- ⇒ Be a good neighbor. Please do not park in any of the parking lots that do not belong to Endeavor Hall.
- ⇒ Smile and wave to Mr. Raubenheimer and Mrs. Wowczuk.

# Afternoon Pick Up

- ◆ All students will walk down to the gym with the classroom teacher at 2:45pm. Kindergarten will be dismissed from the kindergarten playground gate.
- ◆ Students will sit or stand quietly in the gym.
- ◆ Teachers and aides in the gym will monitor students in the gym. Students will only be allowed to leave the gym when the carpool number is called by a teacher/aide.
- ◆ Aides and teachers in the parking lot will call carpool numbers to the front office as vehicles arrive.
- ◆ Carpool numbers will be entered into the Compass Carpool Portal and will be called out in the gym.
- ◆ Students will only be dismissed when their carpool number is called in the gym.
- ◆ Walkers will be dismissed at 3:00pm from the south cafeteria.
- ◆ Students attending Springboard will be assigned a specific area in the gym until Springboard personnel walk the students to the Springboard area.
- ◆ No students will be allowed to wait for parents on the sidewalk or in front of the school.
- ◆ Students remaining in the gym after 3:15pm will call home from the office.
