



## **Endeavor Hall Charter School Local Educator Agency (LEA) Specific License & Endorsement Procedure**

### **PURPOSE**

An LEA-Specific educator license, including areas of concentration and endorsements, is issued by the state board at the request of an LEA's governing body (i.e.-local school board) that is valid for an employee to fill a position in the LEA if other licensing routes for the applicant are untenable or unreasonable. The LEA governing board agrees to provide the documentation and support outlined in R277-301-7.

### **PREPARATION AND SUPPORT FOR LEA SPECIFIC-LICENSE**

LEA Specific-Licenses at Endeavor Hall will only be considered for candidates who are enrolled in a program that will lead to Educator Licensing in the State of Utah, and who will complete their degree and licensing requirements within one, two, or three years. Such candidates must demonstrate that they fit the Mission and Values of Endeavor Hall. All courses, educator preparation and support will primarily be offered through the School that the candidate is enrolled at.

Teachers with an LEA Specific-License will be mentored by a veteran teacher, who will align support given with the Utah Effective Teaching Standards.

### **PUBLIC MEETING OF GOVERNING BODY APPROVING LEA SPECIFIC-LICENSES**

This meeting must have a posted agenda prior to the meeting and an option for the general public to attend and offer comment.
